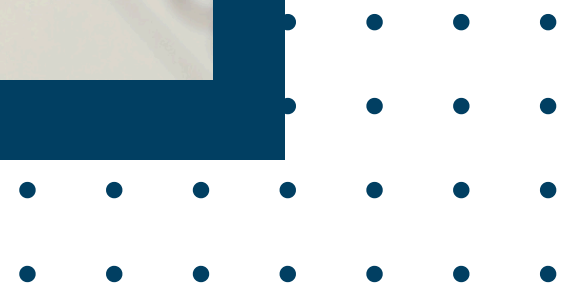

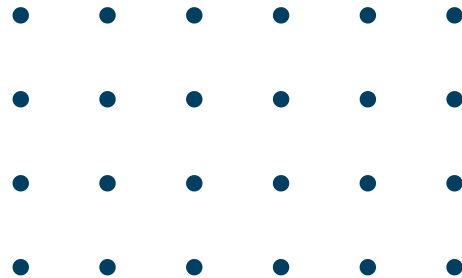

Legislative and Regulatory Update

- **Legislative Update:**

- 160+ meetings with Congress on CERCLA liability protections, low-income water affordability assistance, and other topics;
- AMWA is actively gathering cosponsors and urging members to contact lawmakers; and
- Successful nationwide advocacy campaign reached nearly 7 million impressions.

- **Regulatory Update:**

- Submitted comments on EPA Water System Restructuring Rule and DHS Cyber Incident Reporting Rule;
- Preparing comments on OSHA heat injury rules and PFAS Destruction Guidance;
- Anticipating final EPA Lead and Copper Rule Improvements in October; and
- Expecting MDBP and Perchlorate rulemakings in 2025.

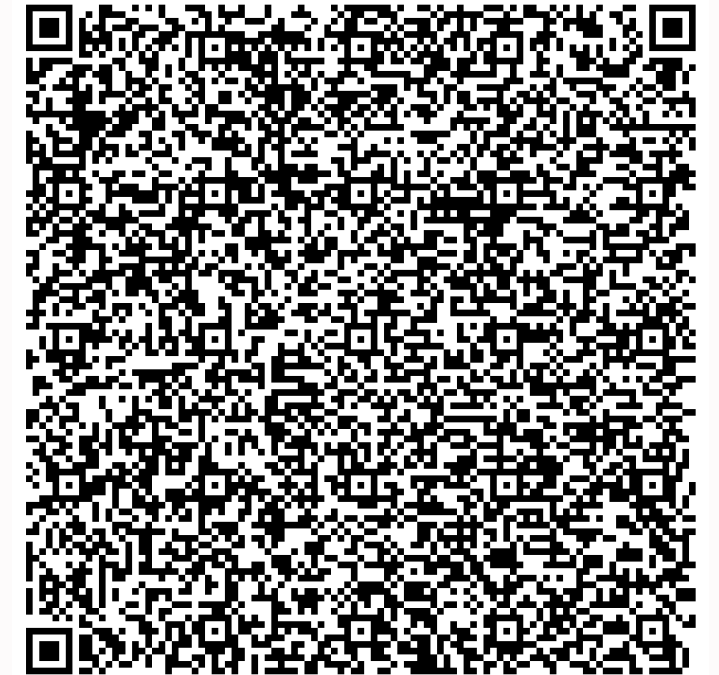
